This event is a casual, interactive drop-in event where parents and students can come to LMS anytime between 5:00 pm and 7:00 pm (w/ last check-in at 6:30) to become familiar with the school, their teachers, their classrooms, and the tools that will make success possible. We highly recommend that students with the last name (A-K) check in between 5-5:45 pm and students with the last name (L-Z) check in between 5:45-6:30 pm. This recommendation will help to prevent overcrowding and allow personalized access to your child's teachers. Each student will have a checklist in their folder with tasks to complete. After completion, students will be given an LMS t-shirt. We also welcome families to stop by the cafeteria before leaving for some ice cream.

Check-In:

- Please check in by entering through the side/gym entrance, which is located to the right of the building after you pull onto the school grounds from Jenckes Hill Rd.
 - (Go to the table of the team your child is on. Last check-in at 6:30 pm.)
- Folders will contain the following:
 - Class schedules
 - Team specific information
 - Student locker assignment w/ combination
 - Skyward directions
 - Beginning of the year forms

Team/Classroom Visits:

- Students and their parents/guardians will head down to their assigned team.
 - To make this interactive, using the checklist received when checking in, students should visit each of the four core classrooms on their team to complete a small content-related task while having the opportunity to meet each of their team teachers.
- Students will be given their locker & combination. Students are encouraged to practice opening their locker (individual locker info in folder) and are welcome to leave any materials they are starting school with.
